## Step 1: Apply for Free and Reduced Lunch: \*\*\*Must apply each year\*\*\*

## Step 2: An email will be sent to you approving or denying your application.

You may also fill out a hard copy, available at Nutrition Services in the Student Food Court. Just ask one of the Nutrition services ladies for a free and reduced lunch application. Once filled out return it to Nutrition Services in the Student Food Court.

Please keep a copy of the letter with you at all times. You should keep the letter on your phone and have a hard copy with you.

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## To Request a copy of Free and Reduced Lunch Letter (if you misplaced yours):

  2. Tell them that you would like to have a copy of your Free and reduced lunch letter emailed to you.

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## \*\*\*Once you Qualify\*\*\*

1. **For Nutrition Services:** You will automatically be entered into their system. You will be given a code that you will use to receive your meals at school.
2. **For required school items purchased from IHS (Workbooks, AP Labs, or most things required for a class)**
  - a. Please see your appropriate assistant principal.
  - b. Please show your F & R letter at the Student Activities Center (SAC) office when purchasing required school items.
3. **SAT/ ACT tests waivers – juniors and seniors are only eligible – not available for freshmen or sophomores**
  - a. Please see your counselor before school, during break, lunch or after school. You will need to bring a hard copy of the letter with you. An electronic version is not acceptable. The library is available for printing. The counselor will review the letter and get the necessary paperwork ready for you within a day.

5. **For school activities (winter formal, prom, grad night, etc.)-** please see your appropriate assistant principal
